

Parking around Lady Margaret Hall

Norham Gardens, Oxford, OX2 6QA

There is very limited visitor parking on site at LMH, and it must be booked in advance. There is on-street parking available on the roads surrounding the College, including Fyfield Road, Norham Road, Crick Road, Norham Gardens and Bradmore Road. Parking charges apply and may vary by street. Parking in Fyfield Road costs £5 per hour and is limited to 3 hours. After 6:30pm and on Sundays there is a single charge of £5. Please take *great care* to check the pay and display terminals for information when you park as charges may change.

We recommend that anyone visiting LMH for more than 3 hours uses the Park & Ride service.

Oxford Parkway Park and Ride - OX2 8HA

Formerly known as Water Eaton, Oxford Parkway Park & Ride is adjacent to Oxford Parkway rail station, to the north of Oxford. It can be accessed from the A40, A34 and A4260.

There are 758 parking bays. The terminal building is open 6:30am to 8pm, Monday to Saturday, and 8am to 8pm on Sundays.

Payment is required within 10 minutes of arrival. There is no need to display your receipt/ticket in your vehicle.

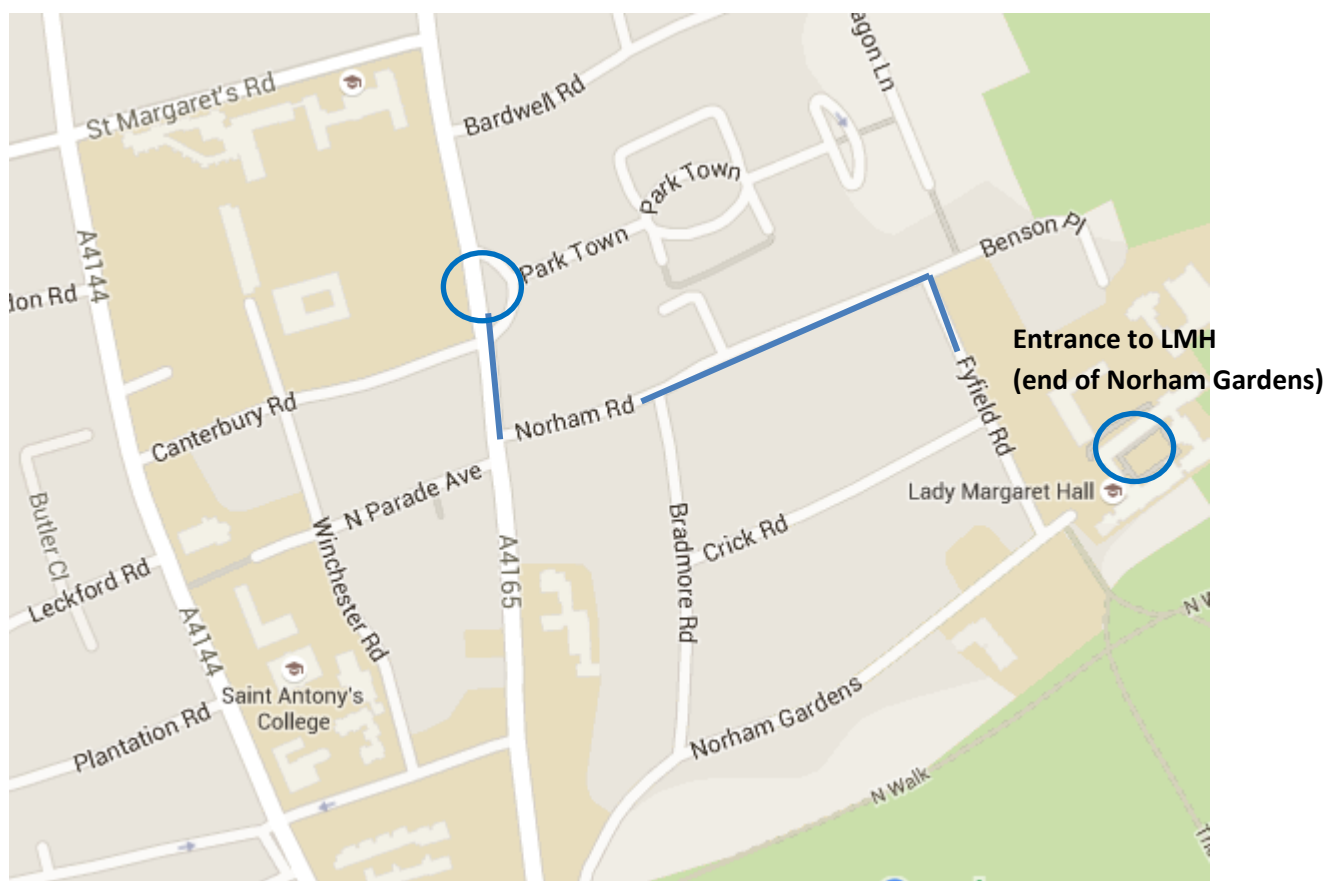
Buses from Oxford Parkway

Take Stagecoach Buses 2, 2A or 7 from Oxford Parkway bus stops A or D. Alight at the Park Town stop and continue along the Banbury Road, taking the first left turn into Norham Road. Take the second right turn into Fyfield Road. LMH is at the end of Fyfield Road.

A single bus fare is about £2.

The bus journey takes 15-20 minutes depending on traffic conditions. The bus stop is about a 10 minute walk from Lady Margaret Hall.

Alternative Overnight Parking

GLOUCESTER GREEN CAR PARK – OX1 2BN

105 spaces

Cars can be left overnight at the Gloucester Green underground car park, which closes at midnight and opens at 7.30am. Vehicles cannot be retrieved or accessed during the closed period for any reason. The car park is reached via steps and has no lift. Blue Badge holders and motorcycles can park for free. Parking cannot be booked in advance, but must be paid for when parking via the ticket machines or via phone. The ticket machines do not take cash.

Gloucester Green car park is about a 20 minute walk from LMH, or a short bus or taxi ride. The city2 bus can be caught at Magdalen Street. Passengers should alight at Bevington Road or Park Town.
